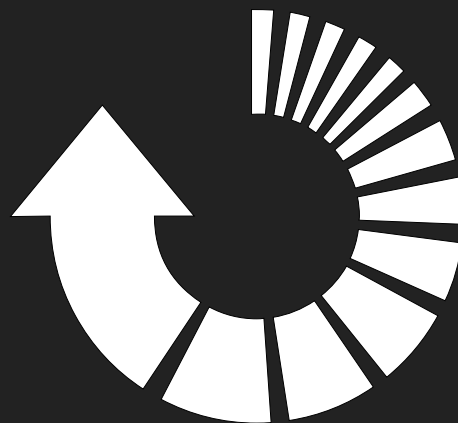

## **Synopsis:**

Twenty4hours is an entertaining, enlightening and sometimes confronting journey into the everyday lives of the inhabitants of one street in a single day.

Each episode centres on a particular famous street in any major city around the world and plunges the viewer into the culture, beliefs, and peculiarities of its people.

Workers and residents, locals and tourists, the young, old, rich and poor, all tell their stories: who they are, what they do, and why they're here. Upon this street. Upon this day. They are unique stories; the stories of love, loss and life.

But most importantly, they are human stories. They are the stories of us.





## Format:

Many cities have one; a street with 24-hour activity. During the day it is the domain to the shopping crowd and working class, at night it is the territory of drunks, riffraff and rabble.

The program focuses on this street, anywhere in the world, where it is never silent, where life goes on 24 hours a day. Who are walking, working, shopping, living, eating, dancing, kissing, laughing, crying, sleeping in this street that never sleeps? See the light changing as well as the color, the smell, the sounds on the street with the passing of the hours?

This program consists of an almost endless series of episodes in which we visit many streets in major cities, from Paris to Phnom Penh, Rio to Rome and Singapore to San Francisco.

From the moment the street wakes up to the moment the last partygoer rolls into bed, we show life in this bustling street. Who catches the first rays? What is there to see? Why does it never stop? Why are people here? What are their goals and dreams and how close are they to realizing them?

Besides an observation of the goings-on in the street, many alluring characters will pass in review: cleaners, street artists, drunks, the homeless, partygoers, couriers, bakers, residents, policemen, prostitutes, taxi drivers, tourists, transvestites, friends, enemies, teenagers in love, teenagers out of love, far-wandering souls, day trippers and night owls.

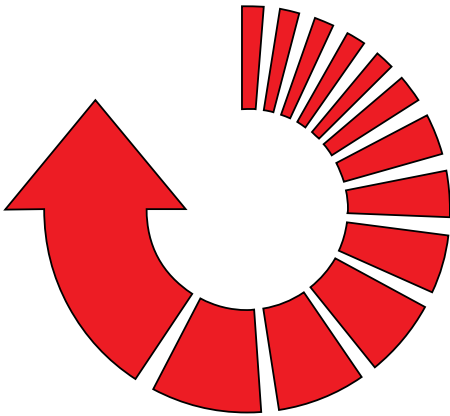
